**Austin, TX** – Connected Texas today announced that Texas Agriculture Commissioner Todd Staples will serve as the keynote speaker for the Texas Broadband Summit, June 5, in Dallas. This unique statewide broadband conference is bringing together government, community, business and industry leaders with a focus of "Getting Every Community Online." The conference also will explore the economic opportunities broadband can offer Texas communities.

Registration is open and details are being confirmed for the state's very first Broadband Summit. The statewide event is being hosted by Connected Texas & the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) to kick off the [TIA 2012: Inside the Network](#) annual conference and exhibition.

"Commissioner Staples is a champion of broadband and we are thrilled to have him confirmed to speak about the ways high-speed Internet can shape our state's economic future," says Connected Texas Executive Director Don Shirley. "Connected Texas research shows that less than half of the state's rural residents subscribe to broadband, which leaves thousands of rural Texans cut off from the economic, educational and quality of life opportunities available through a broadband connection. Our inaugural broadband summit is a major step toward spurring new technology jobs, innovation and closing that broadband gap in rural Texas."

The preliminary [agenda](#) reveals the event's focus on promoting and supporting broadband access, adoption and use across Texas, as well as tackling hot broadband topics like the FCC's Universal Service Fund. Two panels are planned to discuss Broadband Availability and Broadband Access respectively.
